Three Rivers Quilters, Inc.— 2012 Quilt Show

Show Dates: March 29-31, 2012 (Thurs.-Saturday)

General

1. Limit of three (3) quilts per entrant. **If entering more than 1 quilt, indicate your priority for consideration: 1, 2, or 3. Priority will be considered when the number of qualified entries is excessive and must be limited. All entries accepted will be judged.**
2. All entries must be quilted. A quilted entry consists of three (3) layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching. Quilting stitches pierce all three (3) layers and are distributed throughout the entry. **EXCEPT for those placed in the Potpourri category (if offered), no tied quilts will be accepted. NO WEIGHTS OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE QUILT.**
3. All entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years. Please do not submit entries completed before January 1, 2007.
4. All entries must be clean, smoke free, labeled, and ready to hang. Instructions will be included in the jury acceptance letter.
5. No items entered in previous Three Rivers Quilt Shows should be submitted.

Each entrant must submit:

- One completed, signed entry form for each entry
- (2) color photographs (non-returnable), maximum size of 4"x6" for each entry as follows: Full front view & Close-up detail of front.
- Entry fee of \$12.00 for 1st entry, \$10 each additional entry. Members of Three Rivers Quilters, Inc., get their first entry free. Checks made out to "Three Rivers Quilters, Inc." (no cash)
- Legal sized self-addressed stamped envelope for notification of jury decision. Entrants with more than one entry can send one (1) envelope.
- **OPTIONAL SUBMISSION:** Scanned entry form and digital photos accepted – *no faxes*. Email completed documents to registrar below. Entry fees must be promptly mailed to address below. Please add \$1 per entry for processing optional digital submission.

TRQ Guild Reserves the Right

- ▶ to eliminate any category if insufficient entries are received.
- ▶ to re-assign any entry to an appropriate category if a category is eliminated or the entrant selects an inappropriate category.
- ▶ to publish photographs and descriptions of accepted entries in any media and to post the list of winners on our Guild Website (www.threeriversquilters.org).
- ▶ to reject any entry at show time if we discover the rules were violated.
- ▶ to divide categories according to size depending on the number of entries.
- ▶ Entry fees will not be returned unless a category is eliminated and entries cannot be reassigned appropriately.

Security will be provided 24 hours a day during the show.

Insurance during the show will be provided by Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. in the following amounts: \$500 for quilts greater than 48" on the shortest side; \$100 for quilts shorter than 48" on the shortest side. **Be sure to include your quilt on your homeowner's policy or seek additional insurance from an agent if you desire more than our standard coverage.**

Shipping costs to and from the show, including insurance during shipping, are the responsibility of the entrant. Instructions will be included in the Jury Acceptance Letter.

Quilts For Sale: A 10% handling fee collected from sales. A sale price must be indicated, further negotiations permissible.

Three Rivers Quilt Show is a juried and judged annual exhibition of quilts sponsored by Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. to promote the art of quilt making.
